Take charge of your own learning! If you need more practice to learn a new skill or you just want to keep your skills from slipping, here are some resources you can use to stay in peak condition!

All students at Conniston are enrolled in Reading Plus. This program can help you strengthen your reading stamina and improve your comprehension.



On the web, go to <http://login.readingplus.com>
If it asks for a site code, enter **pb0541**
Log in as a student using **pb** followed by your student number (example: **pb23456789**)
Username and password are the same (both are **pb** followed by student number)



All students in grade 6-8 Math classes at Conniston are enrolled in IXL for Math. This program will help you identify skills you need to strengthen to do your best. It then provides a personalized learning program.

Students receive account credentials in Math class.
